7. BUSINESS

a. **Project No. 2020-04 (Mendez)** – Consideration of a proposed accessory dwelling unit at 9119 Fletcher Drive in the R1S-P (Suburban Residential / Scenic Preservation Overlay) zone. The Scott House is listed in the Historic Resources Inventory

Ms. Kinnard presented the staff report. The applicants, Johnny and Margaret Mendez, further described the project.
